

### THE STRUCTURE OF A SEVEN-GLOBE

The diagram shows a lowest seven-globe, having the lowest matter existing. The concentric circles intend to show how higher molecular worlds form concentric layers in the globes, penetrating all their lower worlds as well as extending far beyond them. Atomic matter, however, does not form concentric worlds but exists everywhere in the solar system, penetrating molecular matter.

The seven globes 1-7 enter into the greater essential globe (46:1-7), which is part of one of the ten 49-globes.

The diagram does not show the relative sizes of the globes, nor the distances that separate them.
